APPLICATION ANNOUNCEMENT

Next Aptitude Testing Date: Saturday, February 8, 2020
Deadline to apply: Thursday, December 19, 2019

- Position:** **Apprentice Electrician (Inside Wireman) starting wage: \$22.19/hour + benefits**
This is a five-year apprenticeship program. Apprentices work during the day and attend classes two nights per week. A journeyman certificate is awarded upon successful completion.
- When:** The Tri-County Electrical JATC accepts applications on a year-round basis. The application is online at www.tricountyjatc.org or available **Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9-11 am and 1-4 pm** at the JATC Office located at 10300 Merritt Street, Castroville, CA.
- Process:**
- 1) Applicants must meet minimum requirements.
 - 2) Take the NJATC Aptitude Test (including Algebra and Function and a Reading Comprehension test) (see www.njatc.org or www.electricprep.com website for more information).
 - 3) Qualify for interview if a qualifying score is achieved on the Aptitude Test or other entry method.

Duties:

The Apprentice Electrician works directly under the supervision of and assists a qualified Journeyman Electrician in installing or maintaining a variety of approved wiring methods for distribution of electrical light, heat, power, radio and signaling utilization systems in existing or new building under construction of residential, commercial, and industrial occupancies; including street and highway lighting, traffic signal and other outdoor above and below grade installations.

Minimum Requirements: Each applicant ***must***:

- 1) Be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age at the time of application.
- 2) Provide an official transcript for high school or post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
- 3) Qualify for interview using the NJATC Electrical Trade's Aptitude Test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research or other means.
- 4) Prior to being indentured, applicants will be required to pass a drug-screen test and provide a copy of their DMV printout which verifies that they have a valid Driver's License.

What to Provide in Order to Complete Your Application:

- 1) Valid Driver's License
- 2) High School Diploma, GED, or two-year Associate Degree or higher
- 3) Sealed, embossed, official transcript showing that you have completed one full year of High School Algebra with a "C" grade or better, or one post High School Algebra course with a passing grade of "C" or better. Successful completion of the online NJATC Tech Math class <http://www.njatc.utk.edu/index.htm> will also satisfy this requirement.
